

HOMELITICS AND THE BIBLE – If the evangelist is to maintain an aggressive witness in this generation, and if believers in Christ are to grow and develop into mature and effectively functioning Christians, then it is of the utmost importance that the evangelist provide the sincere milk of the Word through Bible-centered and Bible-derived evangelistic messages. In this lecture Dr. Light will examine the integrity and reliability of the Word of God.

HOMELITICS AND THE AUDIENCE – The preaching evangelist must understand the times in which he lives. How can he better communicate the gospel in a post-modern culture and not compromise the Gospel message. In this lecture Dr. Light will examine the ever changing circumstances of life in light of the constant unchanging truth of the Word of God.
